Giving Thanks for Christmas

Don's sermon Nov. 28 was titled "Preparing for Christmas." There seems to be so much to be done. Above shopping, cooking, wrapping, decorating, cleaning, or sending greetings, consider the preparation of your heart. Is your heart prepared for Christmas?

Galatians 4:4 tells us "But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law,..." God prepared the world so He would send His Son at the chosen time.

Verse 5 gives the reason Christ came. "to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons." If you believe Jesus is your Redeemer, that He died on a cruel cross so you may live eternally in Heaven, and you repent of your sins, asking Him for forgiveness, you receive that adoption.

Verse 6 gives the result of your belief. "And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, 'Abba, Father!'" Your heart is ready for Christmas when you trust in Him completely! I pray that your heart is prepared for Christmas!

When your heart is ready for Christmas, then you are all set for the other aspects of celebration to begin.

Prepare for a time of rejoicing!

Even the angels rejoiced at the birth of Christ! So rejoice with all the fanfare you can muster. Have a birthday party for Jesus. Watch and read uplifting stories of special Christmases. Make memories and traditions. Do not despair over the commercialization of Christmas—consider that the music in the stores, the Nativities sold on shelves, or the message you send in a card may be the only things some people hear about Jesus all year.

Prepare for a time of loving!

Love on your family. Love on your neighbors. Love on those who do a service for you. Love on someone who will be alone for Christmas. Remember how much God loves you!

Prepare for a time of giving!

Of course the greatest gift is found in John 3:16. "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." Giving to family and friends comes from your heart. Don't forget the wonderful charities like The Salvation Army or other non-profits. And missions is an important gift.
