Giving Thanks for His Word

Do we often enough thank God for His amazing Word? If I asked you what God's Word means to you, I would hear

Do we often enough thank God for His amazing Word? If I asked you what God's Word means to you, I would hear many answers. Today let's go to the Psalms to let them tell us reasons to hold great gratitude for the Word.

Starting at the beginning, creation happened when God spoke. "By the word of the Lord the heavens were made,..." Psalm 33:6a

Psalm 119:160 tells us the authority of the Word. "The entirety of Your word is truth,..."

Many Psalms describe "The word of the Lord" with the word "is": ...is proven, Psalm 18:30; ...is right, Psalm 33:4; ...is very pure, Psalm 119:140; ...is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path, Psalm 119:105.

The Psalms tell us what the word of God will do for us: keep us from sin, Psalm 119:11; direct our steps, Psalm 119:133; revive us, Psalm 119:154; strengthen us, Psalm 119:28.

Therefore, the Psalmist gives us how we should react to God's word: "I have kept away from the paths of the destroyer." Psalm 17:4; "I hope in Your word." Psalm 119:14b; "... my heart stands in awe of Your word." Psalm 119:161b; "I rejoice at Your word..." Psalm 119:162a; "I will not forget your word." Psalm 119:16b.

And the final benefit I will offer you today comes from Psalm 119:50b "...Your word has given me life."

My fellow Christ-followers, God even sent the Word to live among us. John 1:1 says "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." Matthew Henry writes so eloquently. "And thus Christ is the Word, ...He is the Word speaking from God to us, and to God for us." Thank Him every day!!


†The children attending VBS at Friendship Baptist, Milner, GA, went by "time machine" to visit Susanna, one of the women who provided for Jesus and the disciples.


